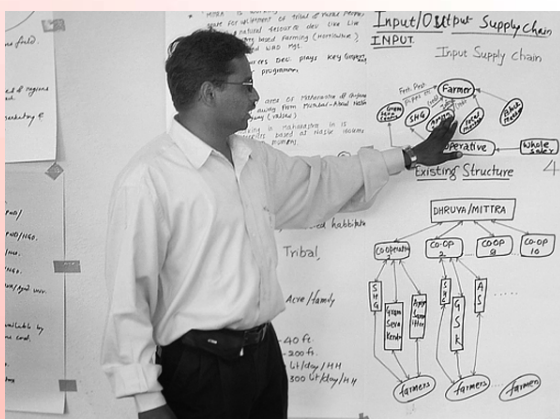

Program

Introduction

Outcome Mapping (OM) is increasingly used as an innovative project cycle management (PCM) approach which focuses on behaviour changes as outcomes of development interventions. OM concentrates on the clarification of roles and responsibilities and on independent actions of project partners right from the start of the project. In this way handing-over-problems at the end of a project cycle can be avoided. Further it emphasizes continuous learning from experiences made along the implementation pathway.

Learn from the Experts: **Agridea International** has practical experiences in supporting projects, programs and organisations in applying Outcome Mapping as well as in training people in the OM approach since 2004. We have worked with OM in Europe (Albania, Germany, Norway, Belgium, Switzerland, UK,), Africa (Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi, DR Congo, Zimbabwe, Madagascar, South Africa), in the Middle East (Lebanon), as well as in Asia (Ukraine, Kirgizstan, Bangladesh, North Korea).

The course objectives

This 5 day training and workshop has three main objectives:

- Get to know and use OM as a new instrument for Project Cycle Management
- Practice planning, monitoring and evaluation while using OM in practical applications in development projects and programmes
- Show the possibility of combining OM with other PCM methods

Learning approach

The course will combine theoretical input by the trainers with group discussion, individual reflection, peer exchange, peer coaching and the elaboration of individual examples and real cases.

- Theoretical introduction to the 12 steps of Outcome Mapping as PCM tool
- Using concrete project examples from both participants and trainers for detailing the theoretical introduction
- Practising and detailing the OM tools on own cases presented by participants
- Group coaching and trainers input for further elaboration of individual examples

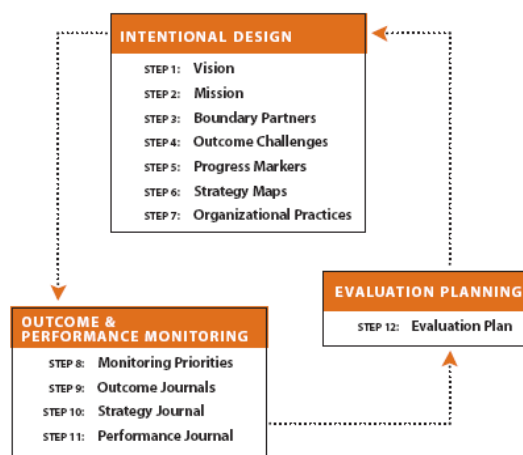


Figure 1. Three Stages of Outcome Mapping

Participants

1. Payment after registration and before participation
